## **KEIGHLEY GOLF CLUB - JUNIOR OPEN**

Monday 4th August 2008

### Conditions:

1. The competition will be by 18 holes of stroke play.
2. Competitors shall start at the time laid down by the Committee, The time allocated will be notified soon after the closing date. However, it is a condition of the competition that, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes.  
***Penalty for lateness beyond 5 minutes is disqualification.***
3. No player may employ a caddie. Penalty: Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round: Four strokes.
4. In the event of ties the result shall be determined in accordance with the rules of the Yorkshire Union of Golf Clubs.

### Entries:

5. Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status & shall sign the declaration to the effect contained in the Entry Form.
6. ***Entrants must be under the age of 18 at 00.00 hours on the 1st January 2008.***
7. Entries will only be accepted from Juniors whose playing handicaps do not exceed **28** strokes for **boys** and 35 for **girls** under the Council of National Golf Unions' handicapping schemes.
8. **THE EXACT HANDICAP CERTIFIED AT THE DATE OF ENTRY WILL BE USED FOR THE PURPOSES OF ENTRY ONLY.**
9. Players shall enter through their Home Club. The secretary of such Club shall sign the declaration in the Entry Form that, to the best of his knowledge & belief, the entrant is eligible & conforms in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status.
